Place value Unit

- Explore Base 10 System with numbers of any size (whole number)

- Explore decimal numbers
 - compare and order decimal numbers with more than 2 decimal places
 - represent decimal numbers on a number line -explore various strategies for multiplication & division of decimals by powers of 10
- Define an equation and introduce low level order of operations (BODMAS) - Build on throughout the year

- Explore transformations of shapes through translation, rotation and reflection
- Perform and describe positions and orientation of shapes under combinations of translations / enlargement (2 lessons).

Cartesian coordinate system

- Explore the four quadrants of the cartesian plane.
- Explore the number plane (consists of a horizontal and vertical axis within four quadrants)
- Name and plot points in relation to the origin using positive and negative numbers.
- Describe transformation on a cartesian plane
